
- a) All upcoming Events and Notices/Circulars including Monthly News of June,2018 are duly uploaded

BOOK RELEASE & ARCHIVE INAUGARATION by THE NATIONAL COUNCIL OF BENGAL



On 9th July 2018, at 5.00 p.m. NCE, Bengal arranged to release a book on Dr.Triguna Sen *"Lessons in Living : Stories from the Life of Triguna Sen"* and to inaugurate an Archive on Dr. Triguna Sen. The ceremony was held in the Indumati Sabhagriha of the Council. The dignitaries after having taken their seats on the dais, the programme started with an opening song. Welcome address was given by Prof. Ananda Deb Mukherjee, General Secretary, NCE Bengal. Dr. Shekhar Dutt, IAS (Rtd.), former Governor of Chhattisgarh released the book, when the first copy was presented to Prof. Mamata Dutta, the elder daughter of Dr. Triguna Sen. Then, Prof. Sati Chatterjee, President, NCE Bengal addressed the august audience. Subsequently vote of thanks was given by Shri K.P.Sing Deo, Vice President, NCE Bengal.

At the end of the programme Dr.Shekhar Dutt inaugurated the biographical archive on

Dr.Triguna Sen's life.

The book not only covers his life but rare photographs ranging from his time in Germany in late 20's to early 30's. Copy of Triguna Sen's Doctorate Award from Technical University in Munich is also included. Excerpts from Interviews with over 20 people including colleagues, students and family and excerpts



from his speeches and excerpts from his speeches and interviews have been included in the book. It also speaks the story of founding of Jadavpur University and his work as Union Minister. The book was researched and written by Dr. Indira Chowdhury (a student and then a teacher atJadavpur University) of Srishti's Centre for Public History, Arch Srishti and designed by Kena. It is available at National Council of Education, Bengal.

NCE, Bengal has also created an Archive of Dr.Triguna Sen with a photo gallery and display of his papers, photo albums, tapes, writings and interviews etc. at the 2ndfloorof the Council building.

Girija Bhusan Pal '48 ME passed away on 14th June 2018.

Prof. G. B. Pal who battled with illness for the last few years of his life retired as a Professor in the Mechanical Engineering department of our university. He was of a very amiable and likeable disposition and very popular with both the students and his peers. He involved himself actively with the students in the annual technical exhibition which used to be held in his early years and also notably as an honorary officer in the NCC where he held the rank of Major in the 8th Bengal Engineers unit. He endeared himself to the cadets by accompanying them to the annual camps held usually in Allahabad, Jhansi and Roorki by personally organizing and accompanying special excursions during the camps.

Tapan Bagchi '75 EE passed away on 6th June 2018.

He was a talented student and being an active member of the Cine club and the Photography club of the university hewas involved in various extra-curricular activities,. He acquired certificate of photography from Photographic Association of Dumdum (Benu Sen's Academy). He was an active N.C.C cadet of 2nd Bengal Air Squadron. He possessed many prizes: Winner of Virendra Singh trophy (All India Best in aeromodelling) in all India Vayu Sena Camp Srinagar in 1972; Winner of Tandon trophy in aeromodelling from all India Vayu Sena Camp, Pathankot in 1973; Received Barma Shell Trophy from Indira Gandhi, our earlier Prime Minister, on the Republic Day in 1973 for the best aeromodelling squadron..
