#### FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Dear Members,

Another year has gone by with the Association celebrating a myriad number of events and activities. We have lost a number of beloved members, including Asit Baran Pal whose sudden and unexpected death came like a bolt from the blue. He did yeomen's service for the Association. Let all the departed souls rest in peace.

In September 2017, the Vice Chancellor of JU informed us personally about the Government of India's decision to grant Rs. 1000 crores to 10 universities each to develop them into Centres' of Excellence. A processing fee of Rs.1 Crore had to be submitted with the application, out of which Rs. 75 lakhs would be returned if not selected and Rs. 25 Lakhs forfeited. The V.C. requested the Association for help in raising at least Rs. 25 Lakhs. I am thankful that our members rose to the occasion from all over the country and abroad and we were able to present this needed amount to the university in November 2017. The outcome of our application is awaited as of date.

Professor Niranjan Roy, Los Angeles Chapter visited us in December 2017 and mooted the idea of developing an entrepreneurship program in conjunction with JU for the students of the university. We await further development on this matter.

Strides have also been initiated by Shri Apurba Mukherjee (Mech) and Shri Ranjit Chakrabarti (Chem) in their recent visits to us to establish a Global Jadavpur University Alumni Foundation, an ambitious but realizable dream to establish a multimillion dollar corpus for assistance to the students as well as for the development of the university to be channelized through our Association.

We are grateful to our Sydney Chapter in providing funds for our own overhead projector which is functioning satisfactorily.

After many years of hard toil, we have completed the amendments of our Regulations and Constitution and these have been approved by the Executive Council and ratified in an EGM held in March 2018. The proposals are being submitted to the Registrar of Societies for final approval. These amendments will go a long way to streamline the functioning of our Association.

Like every year, Memorial Lectures were held for Dr. Trighuna Sen, Prof. Hem Chandra Guha, Prof. Gopal Chandra Sen and Prof. Hiralal Roy - the stalwarts who had dedicated their lives to taking Jadavpur University to its present eminent position.

Members will find details of the other myriad numbers of activities observed by the Association in this publication: the all-day Social, the Students Assistance Programme to 632 needy and meritorious students, Annual Drama, Presentation of gold plated silver medals to 76 toppers of the University, Earn While You Learn program funded by the Washington Metropolitan Chapter, Basanta Utsav, Annual picnic, and other numerous social and cultural events organized by our sub-committees.

Our Website has been upgraded and is now dynamic. I request members to visit the site to get up to date information of the Association.

The tenure of the present office bearers will expire in the forthcoming AGM to be held on May 12, 2018. I shall be also demitting my office and I extend my sincere thanks and gratitude to all members, my fellow office bearers, executive committee members, members of different sub-committees, office staff who have assisted me in performing my responsibilities.

#### ANNUAL CONVOCATION OF JADAVPUR UNIVERSITY

62<sup>nd</sup>Annual Convocation of Jadavpur University was held at the University Open Air Theatre of the main campus on 24<sup>th</sup> December 2017. Honourable Shri Pranab Mukherjee, the ex-President of India, addressed the convocation as the Guest-in-Chief. Honourable Shri Keshari Nath Tripathi, the Chancellor of the University and the Governor of West Bengal presided over the function.

The Convocation was preceded by a Special Convocation when the Chancellor conferred the Degree of Doctor of Literature (Honoris Causa) on Shri Pranab Mukherjee, the 13<sup>th</sup> President of India (July 25, 2012 to July 25, 2017) crowning a political career of over five decades of exemplary service to the nation in Government as well as Parliament; and on Shri Ved Prakash, who has served the cause of education during a career spanning almost forty years starting from a humble position with the Association of Indian Universities to the position of the Chairman, University Grant Commission.

Degree of Doctor of Science (Honoris Causa) was conferred on Shri Ajay Kumar Sood, Secretary General of The World Academy of Sciences (TWAS) and President of Indian National Science Academy and on Shri Arun Kumar Bhaduri, a distinguished scientist and Director at IGCAR, Kalpakkam.

Over 3665 students from different disciplines were awarded undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral degrees.





# PROGRAMME ARRANGED BY STUDENTS ASSISTANCE and AWARD SUB-COMMITTEE (2017-18)

#### Students Assistance and Award Programme (2017-18):

Applications for the renewal of the financial assistance to the JU students were process edduring August 2017 and the fresh applications between September and October 2017. Award ceremony for 137 higher amounts awardees was held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2017 and the occasion was graced by Dr. Satyaki Bhattacharya, Controller of Examination, JU. Ceremony for 245 normal amount awardees was held on 24<sup>th</sup> November 2017 and was graced by Dr. Subir Kumar Chakraborty, Jt. Registrar, JU. Award ceremony for 250 awardees sponsored by Anant Education Initiative (AEI) was held on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2017 and was graced by AEI dignitaries; Dr. Pradip Ghosh, Pro-VC, JU was expected but could not attend due to unavoidable circumstances. Stipends by the Association during the year would amount to Rs. 34,19,000 in addition to Rs. 13,78,500 of AEI contribution which are paid directly to the students' accounts by AEI.

A new endowment has been instituted by Mr. Kumaresh Sinha ('61 Civil) in the memory of his parents Asha & Amaresh Sinha, and would support two higher amount awardees. Mr. Yogesh Nanavati ('61 Electrical) and Mr. Nirmalendu Pal ('61 Electrical) made additions to their existing endowment funds. A list of donors during financial year 2017-18 is given below.

#### **Medal Presentation Ceremony:**

The Association, like previous years, felicitated toppers in the university yearly examination of 2017. This year the award has been extended to 76 (instead of 62 in 2016) including the first year students of 14 engineering departments not included earlier. Each awardee received a gold plated silver medal and a citation in a ceremony held on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

Dr. Partha Pratim Lahiri, Registrar of JU graced the occasion. Preparations have been initiated for the student assistance during the academic year 2018-19. Recipients during the academic year 2017-18, who would be eligible and re-apply, would continue to receive support except for academic and/or disciplinary reasons. Applications would be invited from the fresh intakes of JU into UG courses in all faculties and PG courses in Arts and Science faculties. Candidates would be selected after interview by a panel of JUAA members and faculty representative, and as per funds availability, after taking into account renewal candidates.
